






### **ABOUT SAMARITAN MINISTRIES**

Samaritan Ministries was founded in 1981. We are an interdenominational, volunteer-based Christian ministry that serves Winston-Salem and Forsyth County, North Carolina. Our Soup Kitchen and Samaritan Inn shelter are open 365 days and nights each year to serve people in need.

Our vision: Transforming lives through Christian service.
Our mission: Providing food, shelter, and hope through Christian love.

# **PROGRAMS**



### Soup Kitchen

The Soup Kitchen opened in March 1981, as a part of Crisis Control Ministry. Less than 30 meals were served on the first day.

Samaritan regularly serves lunch to more than 300 guests daily.

The Soup Kitchen is open to men, women, and children who want a hot meal, with no questions asked. Each meal costs \$3.37.

The Soup Kitchen also provides dinner and breakfast to shelter guests. The Soup Kitchen is open llam to lpm. Monday through Saturday and noon to 2pm on Sunday.



### Samaritan Inn: Shelter

The Samaritan Inn shelter opened in 1988, as a collaboration between five downtown churches: First Presbyterian, First Baptist on Fifth, Centenary United Methodist, St. Paul's Episcopal, and Augsburg Lutheran.

Today Samaritan serves homeless men who need safe, temporary shelter for a maximum of 90 days. All shelter guests are referred to appropriate agencies for further assistance with medical care, job training, temporary housing, and other needs.

In 2024, Samaritan provided 24,157 nights of shelter to 468 individual guests. The cost for each guest's night of safe shelter is \$43.52.



### Young Samaritans

Young Samaritans exists to engage young adults in caring for the poor and homeless population of Greater Winston-Salem through involvement at Samaritan Ministries, in order to establish and expand the next generation of volunteers and supporters.

The group volunteers together, helps our fundraising efforts, gathers for fun community socials, and more.



### **Project Cornerstone**

Project Cornerstone was organized at Samaritan in 1995 as a residential, longterm recovery program for former substance abusers. Men live at Samaritan while overcoming addictions, developing job and life skills, and becoming more selfsufficient.

Since its beginning, the program has served over 150 men. Up to ten men are admitted to the program at a time, with an average stay of 13 to 18 months.

#### **2024 YEAR IN REVIEW**



For 44 YEARS, Samaritan Ministries has welcomed guests and provided food, shelter, and hope through Christian love. In over 16,000 DAYS, we have never closed our doors to those in need. We live out our mission statement through our three major programs:



Samaritan Ministries operates the only **SOUP KITCHEN** in Forsyth County. We serve meals to over 300 guests per day. Each meal only costs \$3.37.



THE SAMARITAN INN offers 24-hour shelter along with meals for men experiencing homelessness. The cost per each guest's night of safe shelter is \$43.52.



**PROJECT CORNERSTONE** is a residential long-term recovery program for men seeking to overcome homelessness and addiction. The program focuses on mental, physical, and spiritual needs

Jose Perez suffered the wilderness of addiction. He was lost in his own ways until he found Project Cornerstone. This 12-step program taught him about both the clinical and spiritual sides of addiction, as well as how to become the best version of himself. Now 21 years clean and sober, he serves the unhoused at Forsyth County Library and is pursuing a degree in behavioral science.






